The participants introduced the activity of their Associations; in addition L. Pajek introduced the Croatian Fire Protection Association, F. Kregl the Slovakian Association (APPO), B. Platkevics the Polish Association (All-Polish Association of Fire Protection Products and Rescue Equipment Producers).

- 1) The president, F. Kregl reviewed the past, aims, operation and future plans of the ECEUFIRE cooperation.
  
- 2) F. Kregl handed over the ECEUFIRE Cooperation Agreement to the Slovakian and Romanian partners, and shall send its Annexes (which have been modified and finalized at the meeting) via e-mail.

He shall also send the application form to the new members (Slovenia, Romania, Croatia), which should be delivered to the president, Mr. F. Kregl after completion.

The members of ECEUFIRE welcome the new applicants for membership.

3) The present members of ECEUFIRE and the applicants held a substantial discussion about future ways of cooperation, including following topics:

- Common website: the Hungarian association shall set up the website in English language until the deadline of February 1 for a fee of EUR 2000.-; which fee shall be divided equally between the 8 parties (members and applicants).

Each member shall establish its own site until March 1.

The Hungarian association shall prepare the design plan for this (in order the sites can be managed in a uniform system).

The site

We need to provide advertising opportunity to producers, service providers on the website, so we can finance the site from the advertisement fees.

The members of the Associations should be categorized into 5-6 main groups, according fire protection activity, in order the visitors of the site can easily find a company to their purposes.

- There was a suggestion that the ECEUFIRE members should jointly organize fire protection exhibitions at varying places.

We should decide in this question on our next meeting.

- The president, Mr. F. Kregl informed the participants that the Polish association is organizing a meeting for the leaders of the associations and for the leaders of the fire brigades in the participating countries in the 2<sup>nd</sup> part of March 2011. (Similarly to the meeting in Brno in 2009).

It is urgent to determine the exact date!

- H. M. Nicolescu informed the participants that they received funding from EU

funds for fire protection training and education. They shall investigate whether

there is the possibility for others (members, associations) to receive funds for such purposes.

- L. Pajek informed the participants that the Slovenian association is member of the associations CFPA Europa and CFPA International and maybe ECEUFIRE, or its members could also join these associations. But CFPA does not welcome the application of producers, and our associations all have producer members (in Poland, all members are producers), so, this opportunity may not be suitable for us.
- Mr. F. Kregl informed the participants about organizing an International Fire Protection conference in Ceske Krumlov (Czech Republic), in June 2011. The conference shall have the main topic: Fire Protection of Historical Buildings (Monuments). He kindly invited the member organizations and their members.
